FRIDAY FOLDERS

Since I only spend a portion of each day with your child, I will be sending home a weekly folder to stay in contact with you. Your child will bring home a folder every Friday. This will contain graded work, along with any papers that need to be returned to Mrs. Rae. Please go through your child's folder, sign and return it each

week. Your child will get 5 class DOJO points for returning their folder. This is an important tool for me to keep in contact with you about what your child is working on in my classroom.

HOMEWORK

There are some assignments that a student does not have time to complete in class or needs additional practice on. If your child brings something home, there will be a due date on the top of the assignment. Thank you for your support at home in helping your child complete and return homework on time. It makes all the difference in your child's success.
